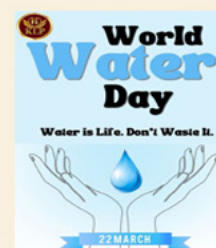


21 March 2026 World Poetry Day Students showcased their creativity through poetry recitation and writing, expressing their thoughts with confidence and imagination.
